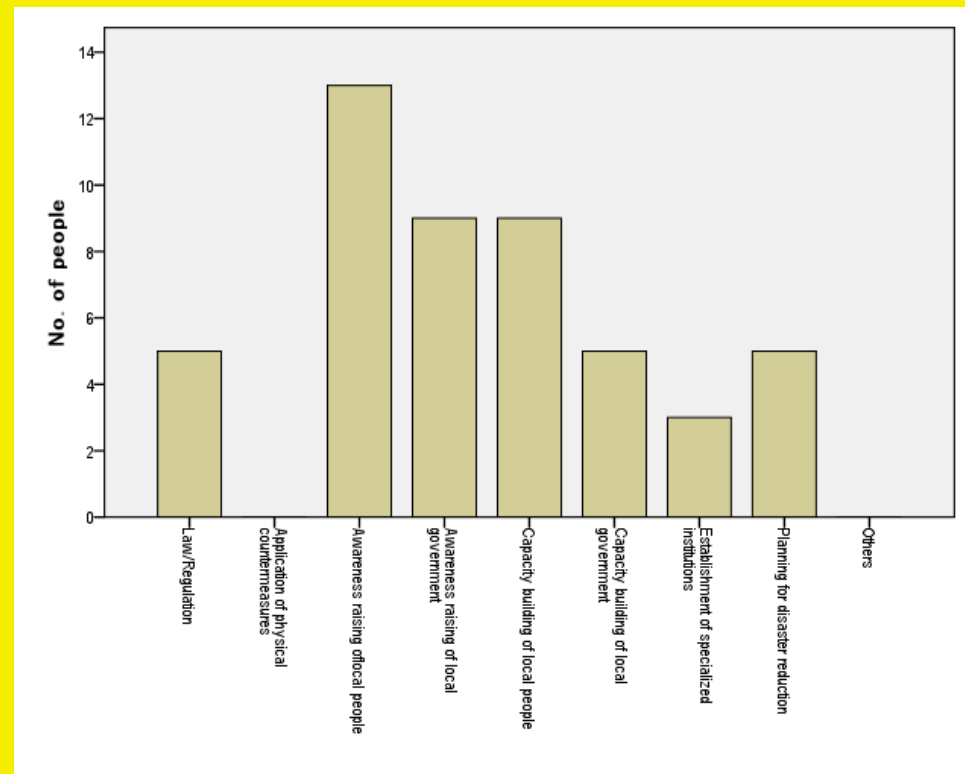

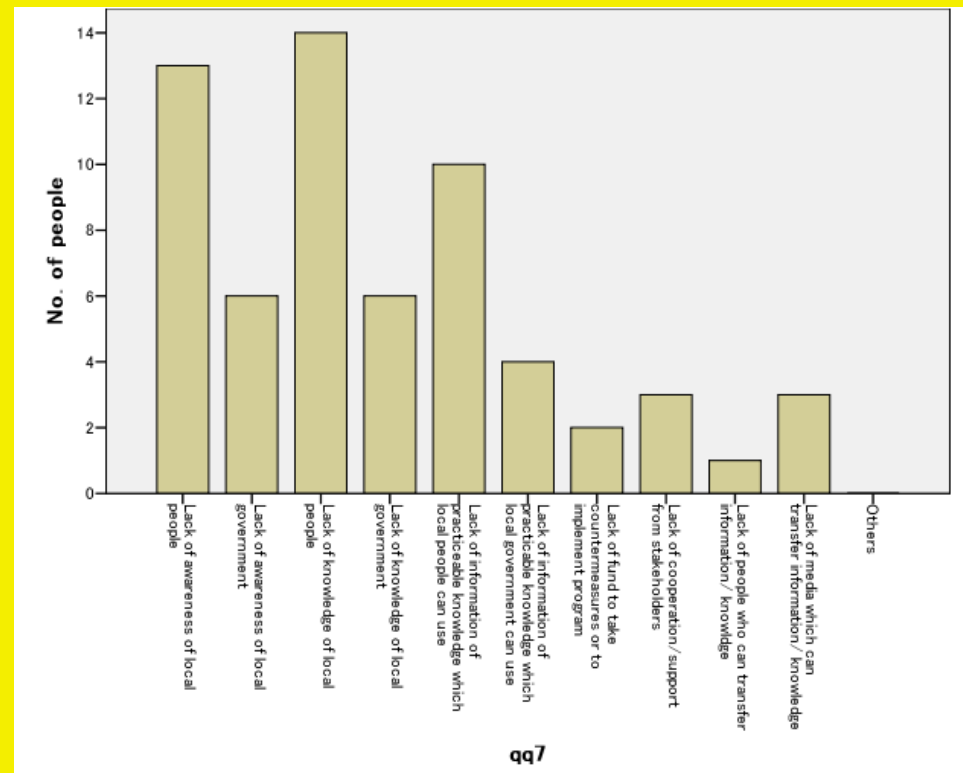


Problems towards enhancing resiliency of communities

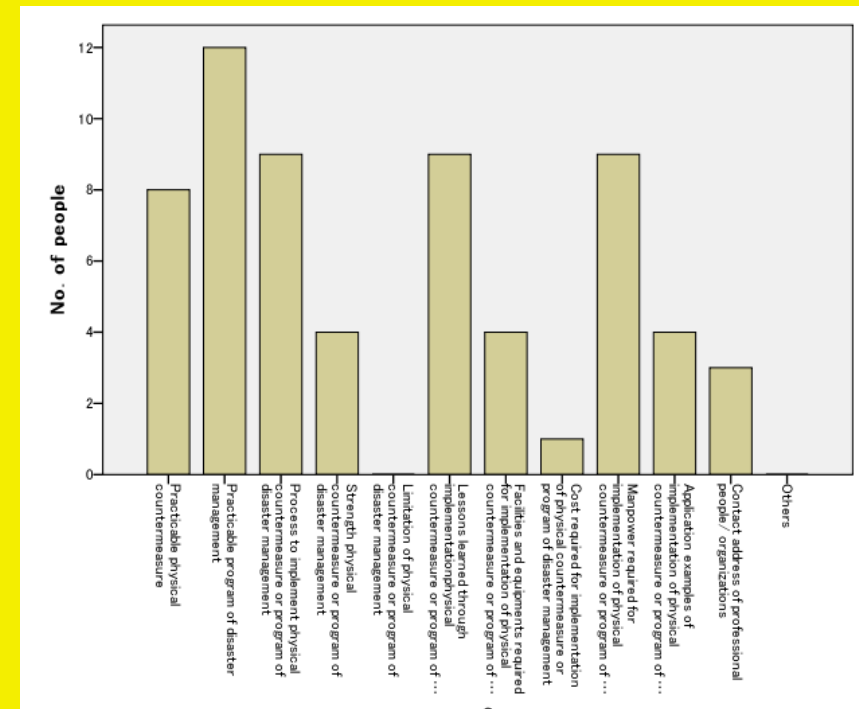


Necessary information as practitioners

- Others

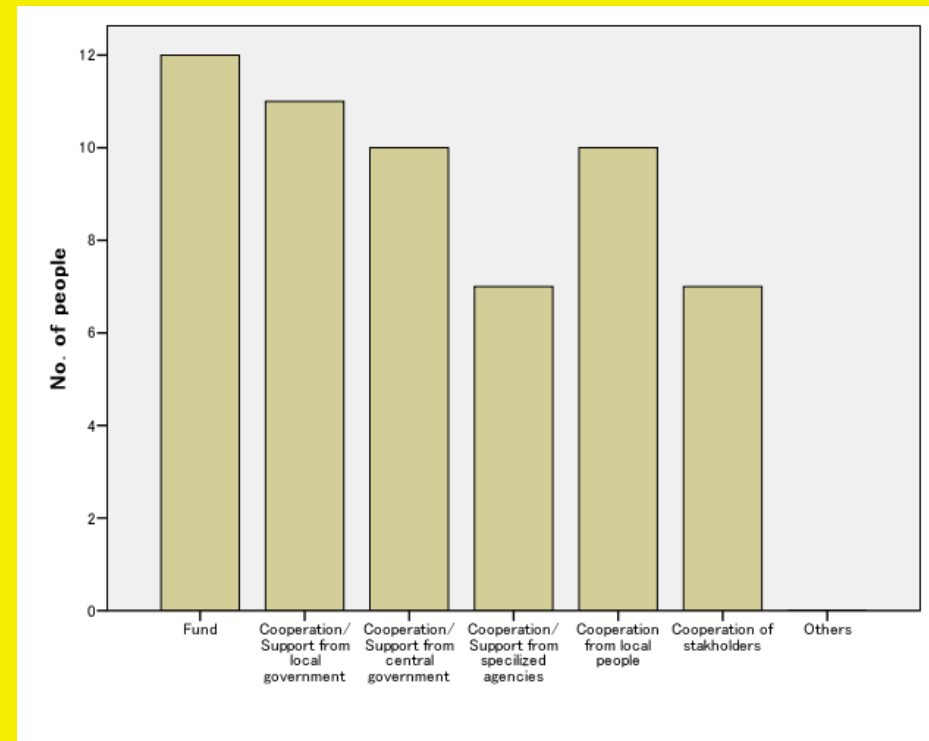


Necessary things for implementation
